Also, there was one of the detainees that was next to his cell. He was very, very ill. He had certain illness before that he was crying for help all night lying on the floor. And like, you know, when the person is that, he was very sad that he cannot provide him with anything. He was calling, "Please bring me a Doctor" all night for hours and hours he was crying and not to be not able to sleep. And he was following that and he couldn't sleep. And he was very sad because he cannot give him, he couldn't give him anything to release that kind of pain that he had.
