For when the Chinese delegation came, for U.S. government to turn all that confidential information to Chinese government. Knowing how the Chinese government may retaliate against the families and putting their families in that jeopardy. That was the worst experience ever for him. Especially, that kind of high hope he had toward U.S. government and Americans. And that was just turned to zero in overnight. It's like, he thought that was just the beautiful words, and the dreams, and the ideas that the U.S. advertised. And this is not the U.S. and that maybe, the Americans are the same.
