Description:

Case binding fully covered in purple wove paper. A small paper manuscript label in ink is adhered to the front cover. No other decoration or titling on the case. No endbands. Endsheets are single folios of yellowed laid paper, tipped to the textblock. Baskin bookplate adhered to the front pastedown. Graphite manuscript on the rear pastedown. Textblock is a single section, printed in black ink on laid paper, and side-stitched.

Condition:

Binding is worn along the board edges, corners, and spine. The front joint is splitting at the head. Small loss to the tailcap. The head edge of the front board is bumped. Both endsheets are in good condition and the hinges are intact. Sewing remains strong. Some soiling and surface grime along the head edge of the text.

Treatment Proposal:

- Dry clean pages
- Readhere lifting covering material at tail of spine.
- Repair splitting front joint and infill loss at tailcap with toned Japanese paper and wheat starch paste

Estimated Treatment Time: 1.5 hours.
