****COMPLETE BEFORE LOAN****

Description:

Text is lightweight white, handmade laid paper that was relief-printed with black printing ink. The text appears to have been trimmed, sewn, rounded, backed and rebound long after the printing date, in approximately the late 19th or early 20th century. The sewing is not visible but there are saw cuts visible in the margins. There are medium-weight white bi-folio endleaves with a bluish tint. There are machine-made red and white striped stuck-on endbands.

The later binding is a quarter-style sheepskin (?) with green and black marbled paper sides and blind and gold stamping and titling on the spine.

Condition:

The text and binding are in very good condition. The text paper is very flexible with very minimal damage, and the sewing and the text consolidation appear very sound. There is minimal ink staining to the lower right corner of the first few pages and minor thumbing. There is a previous western paper repair to the verso of the title page; the mend is secure and non-damaging.
