**\*\*COMPLETE BEFORE LOAN\*\***

**Description:** One 8x10 black and white silver gelatin print on white photo paper. Image measures approximately 5"x7" and depicts a man and a boy in under a tent. Pencil notations on verso read "93128-4", "Rob Amberg 2002 1/3", and "Junior at Dulier(sp?) Gravesite, 1993."

**Condition:**

The photograph is in good condition.

The paper substrate is moderately curled towards the emulsion layer on the recto. There are two small indentations in the upper right quadrant of the image area: a pinpoint indentation just underneath the man's arm and a small curved indentation measuring approximately 3mm on the left edge of his belt. Neither of these areas exhibits cracking or breaking of the emulsion and image layers.

There are several other small indentations visible on the recto of the photograph present on the margins and outside of the image area. The most pronounced of these are located in the center of the margin at the top edge where a small but pronounced crease measuring approximately 7 mm is visible on both the recto and verso, and an indentation at the top edge measuring approximately 12 mm exhibits separation of the print's layers and some small cracks to the emulsion layer there.
